

Lottery & Gaming Credit Information

The lottery and gaming credit provides direct property tax relief to homeowners as a credit on their property tax bill.

The lottery and gaming credit is shown on the tax bill as a reduction in property taxes due. If a taxpayer pays their taxes in two installments, the credit is applied to the first installment.

You may claim a credit if, **on January 1 of the tax year**, you were the owner of the property and **used that property as your primary residence**.

You may only claim one credit.

The Wisconsin Department of Revenue audits the lottery and gaming credit claims.

Once you have applied for and received the credit you do not need to file another application until your primary residence changes.
