PLAN COMMISSION MEETING

February 17, 2021

Mayor Grant called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of agenda

Splitt moved and Iverson seconded a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Approve meeting minutes – December 16th

Iverson moved and Splitt seconded a motion to approve the December 16th, 2020 minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Action items

Resolution – declaring 205 Hamburg as surplus property which is not needed for public use and can be sold (Haas Brewery Stable)

Splitt explained that the Historic Preservation Commission wants to start a Facebook page to list the Haas Brewery Stable for sale. The proper steps must be taken to start the process of selling city property. The first step in the process is for the Plan Commission to recommend approval of a resolution declaring the property as surplus property which is not needed for public use and can be sold. The Plan Commission's recommendation is then submitted to the common council for approval. This will bring more awareness to the property and that the property is for sale. The Historic Preservation Committee's preference is for the stable to remain on the current site over Silver Creek. Iverson moved and Julian seconded a motion to recommend approval of the resolution declaring 205 Hamburg as surplus property which is not needed for public use and can be sold. Motion carried 4-0. Splitt moved and Julian seconded a motion that the common council upon sale consider first the possibility of the structure remaining on the current site. Wurtz explained this would be achieved by recording a covenant on the property, which would run with the land. Motion carried.

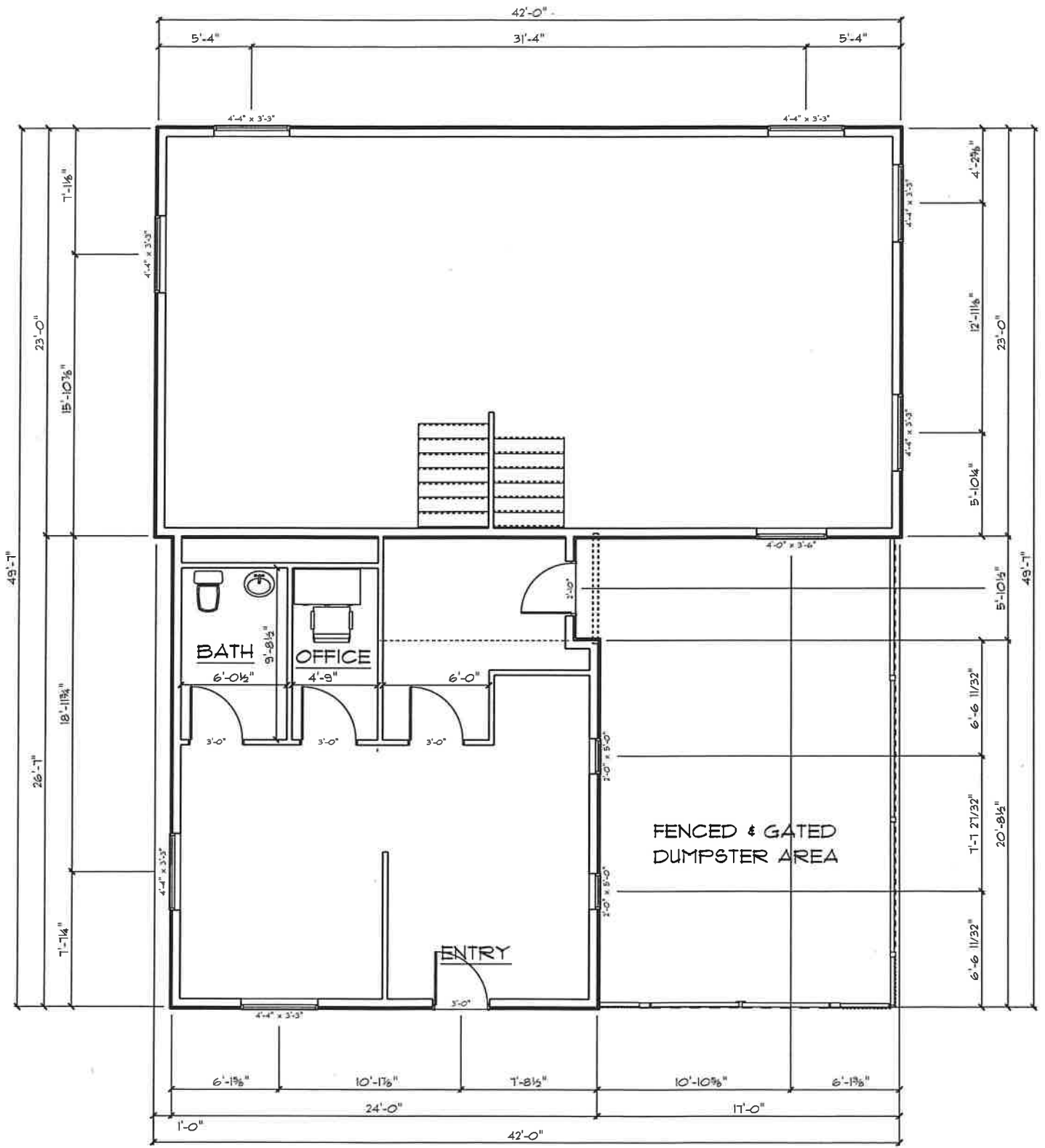
